We have  $p \in \mathbb{N}$ . We want to solve the following congruence for  $a \in \mathbb{N}$ .  $a^{p-1} \equiv 1 \pmod{p}$  To do this, we first rewrite it in the following form:  $a^{p-1} \equiv a^{p-1} a^{p-1} \equiv a^{p-2} \cdot a^{p-1} \pmod{p}$  And then we replace  $a$  with  $a-1$ . So:  $(a-1)^{p-1} \equiv a^{p-1} \pmod{p}$  And finally we use the Euclidean algorithm to find the Euclidean divisor. So:  $\gcd(a-1, p) \cdot (p - \frac{p-1}{\gcd(a-1,p)})(a-1) \equiv a \pmod{p}$  And thus the solution is:  $a \equiv a \cdot (a-1)^{\frac{p-1}{\gcd(a-1,p)}} \pmod{p}$  However, it appears that this solution is incorrect. I think this is because I'm not taking the other solutions into account. Can anyone point out the error of my solution? A: HINT: If you multiply both sides by  $a-1$  and then divide by  $a-1$ , then you get  $\frac{a-1}{a-1} = \frac{a^{p-1}}{a-1}$
